



## **Volunteer Posting Residential Shopping Volunteer**

**Fife House is an innovative, client-focused provider of secure and supportive affordable housing and services for People Living with HIV/AIDS in the greater Toronto Area. Fife House currently has approximately 110 staff working across 6 location.**

Fife House understands that historically marginalized groups in our communities often encounter barriers to full access and participation. We, therefore, commit to actively dismantling all forms of racism and systemic oppression with GIPA/MIPA at the forefront. As a settler agency, Fife House stands in solidarity with Indigenous and Black Peoples across Turtle Island and recognizes the role we have in the work of reconciliation and healing.

Fife House is currently looking for Residential Shopping Volunteers to assist residents with their shopping, either accompanying the resident or obtaining the list and money from staff and shopping for a resident.

The volunteer is expected to travel between our head office location and any of our other location by walking or transit. Transportation tickets can be provided if needed.

### **Reports to:**

The Residential Shopping volunteer will report directly to the Program Manager of the site and will be provided assistance from the Volunteer Lead.

### **Responsibilities:**

1. Provide shopping assistance – either accompany residents who need helps shopping or shop for residents that are not able to shop for themselves.

### **Qualifications:**

1. A clear understanding of Boundaries and Professional Behavior and the importance of client confidentiality.
2. Some personal, volunteer or professional experience related to HIV/AIDS preferred.
3. A desire to volunteer in the social services field is preferred.
4. Some knowledge of group homes and the way they operate is helpful.
5. Has excellent communication and interpersonal skills;
6. Has experience working with cash (if required, a current PRC must be on file).

**Commitment:**

Location may vary depending upon the resident location. A minimum time commitment of six months is required of all Shopping Volunteers.
