Contract Part-time Peer Housing Stabilization Worker

Location: Homeless Outreach Program and Peer Engagement Program

FIFE HOUSE is an AIDS service organization providing supportive housing and support services to persons living with HIV/AIDS. The organization is seeking a dedicated person to cover a contract position in the Homeless Outreach Program. The Peer Housing Stabilization Worker will coordinate Fife House's weekly Housing Help Drop-in. Will recruit, train and support a peer team of 6 to 10 peers for the Housing Help Drop-in, and support the training and capacity building of Fife House's new Housing Help and Health Service Navigation Peer Team.

Requirements include: 2 yrs previous experience in similar environment and/or post secondary diploma or certificate in related field (HSW, social service diploma), knowledge of HIV/AIDS in the current context, crisis management, and experience working with diverse populations including, people who use substances and or have mental health issues. Prior experience with housing search and housing navigation, in the City of Toronto.

Assets: Prior Housing Help or case management experience, prior peer engagement and capacity building experience, First Aid cert., CPR and CIT training, and experience working with volunteers in a direct service setting. Prior outreach and/or drop-in experience, and group facilitation experience.

The Peer Housing Stabilization Worker is a dedicated position for a person with lived experience with HIV.
